FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

As of January 1, 2026

Q: What are my voting rights in the Condominium Association?

- A: At every meeting of the Members, the owner or owners collectively, either in person or by proxy, shall have the right to cast one (1) vote per unit.
- Q: What restrictions exist in the Condominium Documents regarding the leasing of my unit?
- A: Only entire units may be leased. All leases must be in writing and a term of not less than thirty (30) days. No unit shall be occupied by more than two (2) persons per bedroom.
- Q: How much are my Assessments to the Condominium Association for the unit type and when are they due?
- A: Maintenance Assessments for each unit, regardless of size, are \$295.00 per month, due on the first of the month.
- Q: Do I have to be a member in any other Association?
- A: No
- Q: Am I required to pay rent or land lease fees for recreational or other commonly used facilities?
- A: Yes, there is a Land Lease payable in monthly payments as follows:
 - One (1) bedroom units pay \$70.95 per month.
 - Two (2) bedroom units pay \$94.60 per month.
 - Payments are due on the first of the month and must be on a separate check from the maintenance assessments.
- Q: Are pets allowed in the units and what are the restrictions?
- A: No pets shall be permitted in any of the units or on the common elements other than small birds or fish.
- Q: What are the restrictions regarding the use of parking spaces on the common elements?
- A: Parking spaces may only be used for private passenger automobiles; other vehicles, including but not limited to full size-extended cab trucks, campers, recreational vehicles, boats, vans and trailers may NOT be
 - parked in the parking spaces.
